 - C. **Pray for... 2 Timothy 1, 2, 5**

2 Timothy 4:1-2 I solemnly charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction.

2 Timothy 4:5 But you, be sober in all things, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.
 - D. **Pray against... 1 Thessalonians 2:18**

1 Thessalonians 2:18 For we wanted to come to you – I, Paul, more than once – and yet Satan hindered us.
 - E. **Pray for... I Corinthians 16:9**

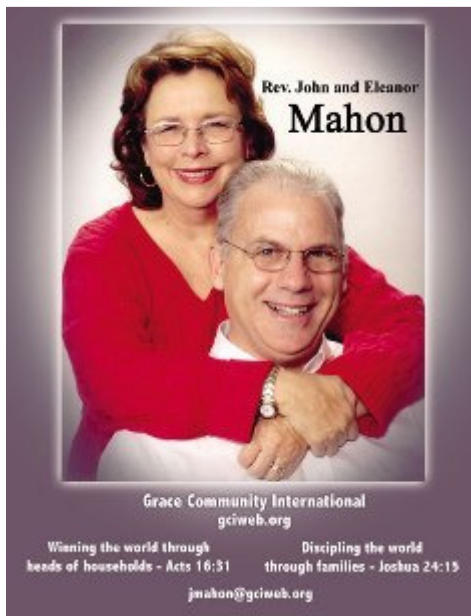
1 Corinthians 16:9 for a wide door for effective service has opened to me, and there are many adversaries.

F. Pray against... II Corinthians 4:3 & 4

2 Corinthians 4:3-4 And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ,

G. Pray for... II Corinthians 4:5 & 6

2 Corinthians 4:5-6 For we do not preach ourselves but Christ Jesus as Lord, and ourselves as your bond-servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.

“O Lord, bless now Your holy, eternal, inerrant, written Word...” Our messages, whether Marriage, Family or any topic begin with this earnest cry to God. This is the objective. Men transformed, born again and zealous for the Lord because of the testimony of their wives in accordance with 1 Peter 3:1. His marriage and family had been so transformed that he came to me to meet each morning. On the third morning he prayed to receive Christ as his Lord and Savior.

These are not suggestions by God the Holy Spirit but standards which qualify or disqualify one from service. It is our privilege to serve the church in equipping its leaders to meet successfully the high standards of God for teaching, leadership and service in His church.

Words: [Philip P. Bliss](#), 1876. This is perhaps the last hymn Bliss wrote before he died in a train wreck. The night before that terrible railroad accident at Ashtabula revival service he said to his audience, "I may not pass this way again"; then he sang a solo, "I'm Going Home Tomorrow." This indeed proved prophetic of his own home going. He survived the initial crash, but was killed trying (unsuccessfully) to rescue his wife from the flames. The lyrics were found in his belongings after the accident. This song is one of the first ever recorded on a phonograph. [George Stebbins](#) made the recording during a demonstration of Thomas Edison's new invention in New York City.
