A. Conserve the fruit

- *John 15:16 " You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you."*
- *Matthew 13:23 "And the one on whom seed was sown on the good soil, this is the man who hears the word and understands it; who indeed bears fruit and brings forth, some a hundredfold, some sixty, and some thirty."*

B. Oppose satan


- *James 4:6-7 "Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you."*
- *1 Peter 5:7-9 "Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. But resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world."*
- *1 John 4:4 "You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world."*

C. Bless the ministry of the Word

- *Isaiah 55:11*
- *So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth;*
- *It will not return to Me empty,*
- *Without accomplishing what I desire,*
- *And without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.*

D. 2 Corinthians 9:6-9 - That God would bless the ministry materially so that we might, in turn, bless those to whom we minister.

- *6 Now this I say, he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.*
- *7 Each one must do just as he has purposed in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.*
- *8 And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed;*

(William Williams Born: February 11, 1717, Pantycelyn, Wales. Died: January 11, 1791, Pantycelyn, Wales. Williams was born to a poor family, and intended to become a clergyman for the Sacramentarian Church (or "high church") until he heard Howell Harris' preaching and decided to join the Dissenters. In the next 43 years he traveled 95,900 miles, bringing the Gospel to his country. Although he was a fine preacher, his 800 or more Welsh hymns are what endeared him most to the people. As a cultural/historical note it was featured in the film "How Green Was My Valley" and sung at Princess Diana's Funeral)
