B. Tuesday

1. Victory Passages

- a. *Matthew 16:18 "And I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades shall not overpower it. (Meaning: At satan's final judgment he is confined to hell and cannot come out and do mischief as he did in Eden. The church is eternally safe from satan and his demons.)"*
- b. *John 12:30 – 33 Jesus answered and said, "This voice has not come for My sake, but for your sakes. Now judgment is upon this world; now the ruler of this world shall be cast out. And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to Myself." But He was saying this to indicate the kind of death by which He was to die.*
- c. *John 16:8 -11 "And He, when He comes, will convict the world concerning sin, and righteousness, and judgment; concerning sin, because they do not believe in Me; and concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, and you no longer behold Me; and concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged.*

E. Friday

1. Victory Passages

- a. *Hebrews 2:12 - 16 saying, "I will proclaim Thy name to My brethren, In the midst of the congregation I will sing Thy praise." And again, "I will put My trust in Him." And again, "Behold, I and the children whom God has given Me. Since then the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil; and might deliver those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives. For assuredly He does not give help to angels, but He gives help to the descendant of Abraham.*
- b. *James 4:7 Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.*

F. Saturday

1. Victory Passages

- a. *I John 2:12 – 14 I am writing to you, little children, because your sins are forgiven you for His name's sake. I am writing to you, fathers, because you know Him who has been from the beginning. I am writing to you, young men, because you have overcome the evil one. I have written to you, children, because you know the Father. I have written to you, fathers, because you know Him who has been from the beginning. I have written to you, young men, because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the evil one.*
- b. *I John 3:7 & 8 Little children, let no one deceive you; the one who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous; the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, that He might destroy the works of the devil.*
- c. *I John 4:1 – 4 Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world. By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God; and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God; and this is the spirit of the antichrist, of which you have heard that it is coming, and now it is already in the world. You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.*
- d. *I John 5:4 – 6 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world-- our faith. And who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God? This is the one who came by water and blood, Jesus Christ; not with the water only, but with the water and with the blood.*

2. Specifically Oppose These Evil Works

- a. *Ephesians 6:12, 13 – Waging war on the people of God*
- b. *Ephesians 6:16 – Hurling flaming missiles*
- c. *I John 5:18, 19, 21 – The touch, power and idolatrous influence he exerts*

G. Sunday

1. Victory Passages

And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.*

Protection Of God

World - Mark 4:19 "and the worries of the world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the desires for other things **enter in and choke the word**, and it becomes unfruitful."

Flesh - I Peter 2:11 "Beloved, I urge you as aliens and strangers to abstain from fleshly lusts, which **wage war against the soul**."

Devil - I Peter 5:8 "Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls about like a roaring lion, **seeking someone** to devour."

Sin - Psalm 65:3 "Iniquities **prevail against me**; as for our transgressions, Thou dost forgive them."

Men - Psalm 27:12 "Do not deliver me over to the desire of my adversaries; for false witnesses have **risen against me**, and such as breathe out violence."

1. Genesis 4:7 "If you do well, will not your countenance be lifted up? And if you do not do well, **sin is crouching at the door**; and its desire is for you, but you must master it."
2. Genesis 39:10 And it came about as **she spoke to Joseph day after day**, that he did not listen to her to lie beside her, or be with her.
3. Psalm 65:3 **Iniquities prevail against me**; As for our transgressions, Thou dost forgive them.
4. Judges 16:16-17 And it came about when **she pressed him daily with her words and urged him**, that his soul was **annoyed to death**. So he told her all that was in his heart and said to her, "A razor has never come on my head, for I have been a Nazirite to God from my mother's womb. If I am shaved, then my strength will leave me and I shall become weak and be like any other man."
5. Psalm 40:12 **For evils beyond number have surrounded me; My iniquities have overtaken me**, so that I am not able to see; they are more numerous than the hairs of my head; and my heart has failed me.
6. Psalm 119:133 Establish my footsteps in Thy word, and do not let any iniquity have dominion over me.
7. Psalm 140:1-5 **Rescue me, O LORD, from evil men; preserve me from violent men**, Who devise evil things in their hearts; they continually stir up wars. They sharpen their tongues as a serpent; poison of a viper is under their lips. . Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me from violent men, **who have purposed to trip up my feet. The proud have hidden a trap for me, and cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set snares for me.** .
8. **Psalm 141:4 Do not incline my heart to any evil thing, to practice deeds of wickedness with men who do iniquity; and do not let me eat of their delicacies. (1985 – OSU; turned down supervisory position)**
9. Dan 1:5 **And the king appointed for them a daily ration from the king's choice food and from the wine which he drank, and appointed that they should be educated three years, at the end of which they were to enter the king's personal service.**
10. Luke 4:13 And when the devil had finished every temptation, he departed from Him until **an opportune time**.
11. Romans 7:8 But **sin, taking opportunity** through the commandment, **produced in me** coveting of every kind; for apart from the Law sin is dead.
12. Romans 7:11 for **sin, taking opportunity** through the commandment, **deceived me**, and through it killed me.
13. Romans 7:23 but I see a different law in the members of my body, **waging war against the law of my mind**, and making me a prisoner of the law of sin which is in my members.
14. Romans 13:14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and **make no provision for the flesh** in regard to its lusts.
15. 2 Corinthians 2:11 in order that no advantage be taken of us by Satan; **for we are not ignorant of his schemes**.

2. Ps 44:6-8 **For I will not trust in my bow, Nor will my sword save me. But You have saved us from our adversaries, And You have put to shame those who hate us. In God we have boasted all day long, And we will give thanks to Your name forever. .**
3. Ps 56:11 **In God I have put my trust, I shall not be afraid. What can man do to me?**
4. Ps 62:9-12 **Men of low degree are only vanity and men of rank are a lie; In the balances they go up; They are together lighter than breath. Do not trust in oppression And do not vainly hope in robbery; If riches increase, do not set your heart upon them. Once God has spoken; Twice I have heard this: That power belongs to God; And lovingkindness is Yours, O Lord, For You recompense a man according to his work.**
5. Ps 140:1-8 **Rescue me, O LORD, from evil men; Preserve me from violent men Who devise evil things in their hearts; They continually stir up wars. They sharpen their tongues as a serpent; Poison of a viper is under their lips. . Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; Preserve me from violent men Who have purposed to trip up my feet. The proud have hidden a trap for me, and cords; They have spread a net by the wayside; They have set snares for me. . I said to the LORD, "You are my God; Give ear, O LORD, to the voice of my supplications. O GOD the Lord, the strength of my salvation, You have covered my head in the day of battle. Do not grant, O LORD, the desires of the wicked; Do not promote his evil device, that they not be exalted. .**
6. Isa 41:9-15 **You whom I have taken from the ends of the earth, And called from its remotest parts And said to you, 'You are My servant, I have chosen you and not rejected you. Do not fear, for I am with you; Do not anxiously look about you, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, surely I will help you, Surely I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.' Behold, all those who are angered at you will be shamed and dishonored; Those who contend with you will be as nothing and will perish. You will seek those who quarrel with you, but will not find them, Those who war with you will be as nothing and non-existent. For I am the LORD your God, who upholds your right hand, Who says to you, ' Do not fear, I will help you.' Do not fear, you worm Jacob, you men of Israel; I will help you," declares the LORD, " and your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel. Behold, I have made you a new, sharp threshing sledge with double edges; You will thresh the mountains and pulverize them, And will make the hills like chaff.**

(John Henry Yates Born: November 21, 1837, Batavia, New York. Died: September 5, 1900, Batavia, New York. Yates worked in a number of jobs, including shoe salesman, newspaper editor, and hardware store manager. He became a Methodist minister in 1886, and later pastor of the West Bethany Free Will Baptist Church. Ira Sanky evangelist D.L. Moody's song leader wrote the music for this stirring call to action.)

A Mighty Fortress Is Our God

A mighty fortress is our God, A bulwark never failing; A helper He amid the flood Of mortal ills prevailing. For still our ancient foe, doth seek to work us woe – his craft and power are great, and armed with cruel hat, On earth is not his equal.

Did we in our own strength confide, Our striving would be losing, Were not the right Man on our side, The Man of God's own choosing, Dost ask who that may be? Christ Jesus, it is He – Lord Sabaoth His name, From age to age the same, An He must win the battle.

And though this world with devils filled, Should threaten to undo us, We will not fear for God hath will His truth to triumph through us. The prince of darkness grim, We tremble not for him – His rage we can endure, For lo, his doom is sure; One little word shall fell him.

That word above all earthly powers, No thanks to them, abideth; The Spirit and the gifts are ours Through Him who with us sideth. Let goods and kindred go, This mortal life also – The body they may kill; God's truth abideth still; His kingdom is forever.

(Martin Luther *Born:* November 10, 1483, Eisleben, Germany. *Died:* February 18, 1546, Eisleben, Germany. Luther began the Protestant Reformation in 1517, and the Lutheran denomination bears his name to this day. In addition to being a reformer, he was quite active in the area of church music.) “Unless I am convinced from or by plain and clear reasons and arguments, I can and will not retract, for it is neither safe nor wise to do anything against conscience. Here I stand, I can do no other. God help me – AMEN” Martin Luther

In 1720 a remarkable revival began in a town in Moravia. Jesuits opposed it, and the meetings were prohibited. Those who still assembled were seized and imprisoned in stables and cellars. At David Nitschmann's house, where a hundred and fifty persons gathered, the police broke in and seized the books. Not dismayed, the congregation struck up the stanzas of Luther's hymn,

“And though this world, with devils filled,
Should threaten to undo us;
We will not fear, for God hath willed
His truth to triumph through us.

Twenty heads of families were for this sent to jail, including Nitschmann, who was treated with special severity. He finally escaped, fled to the Moravians at Herrnhut, became a bishop, and afterwards joined the [Wesleys](#) in 1735 in their expedition to Savannah, Georgia.
