(Bernard of Clairvaux *Born:* 1091, in his father's castle at Les Fontaines (near Dijon), Burgundy; *Died:* August 21, Bernard's father Tecelin was a knight and vassal of the Duke of Burgundy. Bernard was educated at Chatillon, where he was distinguished by his studious and meditative habits. He entered the monastery of Citeaux (the first Cistercian institution) in 1113. Two years later, he was sent, with 12 other monks, to found a daughter monastery in the Valley of Wormwood, about four miles from the Abbey of La Ferté, on the Aube. Bernard was a man of exceptional piety and spiritual vitality. [Martin Luther](#), 400 years later, called him, "the best monk that ever lived, whom I admire beyond all the rest put together." He also wrote "O Sacred Heart Now Wounded")
