<p>2 Timothy 2:13</p>  <p>If we are unfaithful, he remains faithful, since he cannot deny himself.</p> <p>NET</p>	<p>2 Timothy 2:14</p>  <p>Remind people of these things and solemnly charge them before the Lord not to wrangle over words. This is of no benefit; it just brings ruin on those who listen.</p> <p>NET</p>

<p>2 Timothy 2:17</p>  <p>and their message will spread its infection like gangrene.
