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SEVEN Things to PRAY for MYSELF

1 Kings 8:28

Yet have regard to the prayer of Your servant and to his supplication, O LORD my God, to listen to the cry and to the prayer which Your servant prays before You today;

Monday - Matthew 4:22 That I would allow them to leave, being satisfied with honor and neither demand nor expect obedience.

Tuesday - Proverbs 12:18; 21:23 That I would not give opinions or ask nousey questions about work, church, babies, marriage or children unless asked.

Wednesday - Hebrews 12:15; Ephesians 4:31 That I would not become bitter, coarse or angry at my life, the church, my family nor my God.

Thursday - Colossians 4:6; Hebrews 3:13 That I would be positive and upbeat around them. That I would not be fearful but rather a ray of sunshine in their lives.

Friday - Luke 17:10; II Corinthians 4:5 That I would never say, "Why don't you... call/write/visit?" but instead take the initiative.

Saturday - Leviticus 19:11 That I would be open and honest with them about my health. That I would not hide serious problems and I would not incessantly talk about minor health problems, aches and body fluids.

Sunday - Proverbs 17:6 That I would not embarrass them as I age but remain faithful to the Lord, His church and my marriage vows. (That I would act my age).

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
