 - 2 Corinthians 1:11 "you also joining in helping us through your prayers, so that thanks may be given by many persons on our behalf for the favor bestowed on us through the prayers of many."
 - A. Jesus Christ, during His earthly ministry prayed in John 17:17 "Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth." Ask God to use His holy, eternal, inerrant written Word to set these families apart for God's service and God's glory.
 - B. Please claim Hebrews 4:12, that as they apply the Word to their daily devotionals that God's Word would bring them to repentance. "For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart."
 - C. Ask God, that as promised in Isaiah 55:11, that His Word would accomplish His purpose in the lives of these families. "So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth; It will not return to Me empty, Without accomplishing what I desire, And without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it."
 - D. Petition the Lord of the harvest, that as taught in 2 Thessalonians 3:1, that God's Word would result in fruit, not only in these families but also in families whom they will reach.


- "Finally, brethren, pray for us that the word of the Lord will spread rapidly and be glorified, just as it did also with you;"
- E. That God would bless the ministry materially, that we might in turn bless those to whom we minister. This is the truth taught by God the Holy Spirit in 2 Corinthians 9:12-14. As you pray over this verse ask God to make it true in our ministry as well.

14 while they also, by prayer on your behalf, yearn for you because of the surpassing grace of God in you.





Dear Prayer Warriors,



Be thou my Wisdom and thou my true word I ever with thee and thou with me Lord Thou my great Father, I Thy true son, Thou in me dwelling and I with Thee one.

Be Thou my battle Shield, Sword for the fight; Be Thou my Dignity, Thou my Delight; Thou my soul's Shelter, Thou my high Tower: Raise Thou me heavenward, O Power of my power.

Riches I heed not nor mans empty gain, Thou my inheritance now and always. Thou and thou only first in my heart, High king of heaven my treasure thou art. High king of heaven, my victory won, My I reach heavens joys, O bright heaven's son, Heart of my own heart, whatever may befall Still be my Vision, O Ruler of all.

(Words: Attributed to Dallan Forgaill, 8th Century. Little is known of this man beyond this poem written sometime in the 8th Century (*Rob tu mo bhoile, a Comdi cride*); translated from ancient Irish to English by Mary E. Byrne, in "Eriú," *Journal of the School of Irish Learning*, 1905, and versed by Eleanor H. Hull, 1912, alt.

Music: Slane, of Irish folk origin (MIDI, score). Slane Hill is about ten miles from Tara in County Meath. It was on Slane Hill around 433 AD that St. Patrick defied a royal edict by lighting candles on Easter Eve. High King Logaire of Tara had decreed that no one could light a fire before Logaire began the pagan spring festival by lighting a fire on Tara Hill. Logaire was so impressed by Patrick's devotion that, despite his defiance (or perhaps because of it), he let him continue his missionary work. The rest is history.)
