- B. Ask God to open the doors to Nigeria, South Africa and Cuba, that we might fulfill those Macedonia Calls which have gone out to us.

- 8' I know your deeds. Behold, I have put before you an open door which no one can shut,*
- because you have a little power, and have kept My word, and have not denied My name.*

*Colossians 4:3-4*

- 3 praying at the same time for us as well, that God will open up to us a door for the word,*
- so that we may speak forth the mystery of Christ, for which I have also been imprisoned;*

*4 that I may make it clear in the way I ought to speak.*


C. That God would bless the ministry materially, that we might in turn bless those to whom we minister. Please take a moment to pray these passages for our ministry...

*Joseph Hart* Born: 1712, London, England. Died: May 24, 1768, London, England. Buried: Bunhill Fields Cemetery, London England. [John Bunyan](#), [John Rippon](#) & [Isaac Watts](#) lie nearby. Hart resisted Christianity while young, writing the pamphlet *The Unreasonableness of Religion, Being Remarks and Animadversions on the Rev. John Wesley's Sermon on Romans 8:32*. However, Hart came to Christ in 1757, becoming an enormously popular preacher and hymn writer. Tens of thousands attended his funeral.
