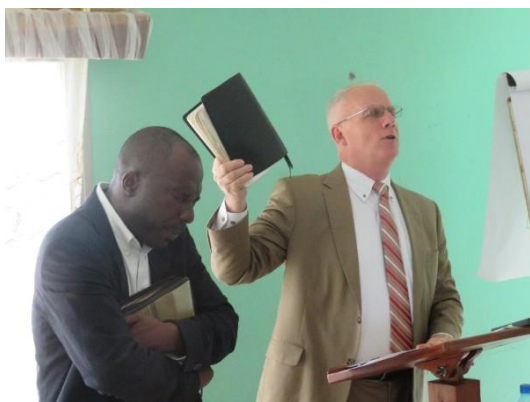




Preparing the Ground
