



Three-Fold Cord of Missions in Cameroon

Dear Prayer Warriors,

Our time in Cameroon exemplified the three-fold cord of missions as the GCI team and those to whom we ministered continuously experienced the blessings of those who give, go and pray.



Those who give...

Proverbs reminds us that "the generous man will be prosperous, and he who waters will himself be watered" (Prov. 11:25). Your generosity overflowed as the GCI team entered Cameroon with 23 boxes containing 150 Bibles and more than 400 Bible study aids including books on theology, Bible dictionaries, and evangelism. Additionally, we distributed 100 back packs to local pastors and lay leaders filled with study materials such as paper, pens, and pencils so that those attending our conferences could take notes and return to their home churches to teach these same truths to others. Finally, we sponsored 80 pastors to attend conferences, supplied a dozen pairs of reading glasses to ministers, and gave to our partnering churches and organizations 75 flash drives filled with conference lectures, quiet time materials, and other pastoral resources. Thank you for providing the life-giving water of the Gospel and God's Word to our brothers and sisters in Christ in Cameroon!

Our Lord Jesus Christ exhorted us that "the harvest is plentiful but the laborers are few; therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest" (Luke 10:2). For this trip to Cameroon, the Lord blessed me with two faithful fellow

During our two week stay in Yaoundé, we spoke at more than 130 conference sessions and workshops in addition to preaching at six Sunday morning church services.
