

1_Here we are departing – 17 boxes of Bibles and Bible study aids. The last slide is of our return to the US – we come full, we leave empty, that is the objective.






2_ The problem: Ministers of the Gospel using Bibles held together by tape.



3 – 8 You can see in these pictures the smiles of joy from those receiving these precious volumes. There are no Christian publishing houses in the entire country of Cameroon, where quality leather study Bibles may be acquired. Even if they could find them, the cost of a single leather study Bible exceeds the monthly salary of those pictured. Without your faith, prayers and generosity this ministry would not be possible. One pastor told me that he had been saving for three years for a Bible. He then shared that the man who was going to bring one back for him from the US was transferred to another country. Now, even when he finished saving, he had no access to a Bible. With tears of joy he received, at no cost, a leather study Bible with his name imprinted on it. This is one of hundreds of stories – all the same. Your faith is changing the lives and ministries of pastors and churches across Cameroon. Without your generosity, this ministry would not be possible.





9_ Here we are departing. We come full and leave empty. I tell those to whom we minister that we work on the “sucked orange principle.” We come full, like a fresh orange, and, when we leave we want to be empty--peeled open, sucked dry, with only the skin left to be discarded. We seek to minister as Paul in *2 Corinthians 12:15* ***“I will most gladly spend and be expended for your souls. If I love you more, am I to be loved less?”***

Fanny Crosby

Frances Jane Crosby *Born:* March 24, 1820, Putnam County, New York. *Died:* February 12, 1915, Bridgeport, Connecticut Fanny Crosby was probably the most prolific hymn-ist in history. Though blinded by an incompetent doctor at six weeks of age, she wrote over 8,000 hymns. About her blindness, she said: **"It seemed intended by the blessed providence of God that I should be blind all my life, and I thank him for the dispensation. If perfect earthly sight were offered me tomorrow I would not accept it. I might not have sung hymns to the praise of God if I had been distracted by the beautiful and interesting things about me."** In her lifetime, Fanny Crosby was one of the best known women in the United States. To this day, the vast majority of American hymnals contain her work.
