


Departing for Cuba

Now I have the privilege of ministering to over 50 Baptist pastors on the topics of personal discipleship, marriage, and family with Dan serving as my translator. How I praise God for providing faithful friends and partners in the ministry like Dan! Over the next 36 hours, please join us in praying over these key travel times as GCI travels for the first time to Latin America.

Arriving in Cuba. Please pray for clear weather upon our arrival as this is hurricane and tropical storm season in the region (Psalm 107:29).



Customs in Cuba. Please pray that all of the boxes of ministry supplies would easily clear customs and for us to safely connect with our hosts (Daniel 1:9).
