

# God's Hand at Work

The middle of October found former GCI board member Dan Clark and myself boarding a plane bound for the eastern end of the nation of Cuba. This trip marked the 28th country and 75th city in which Grace Community International has ministered since its founding in 2000. How we praise God for faithful support partners such as yourself whose prayers and gifts God continues to use to expand our reach - now further into the Spanish-speaking world! Read on to find out more about how God's hand worked through your prayers during the 10 days we spent ministering to local pastors and their congregations in Holguin Province, Cuba.

### Like channels of water

We asked you to pray Proverbs 21:1 over our entry into Cuba, knowing that the king's heart is like channels of water in the hand of the Lord; He turns it wherever He wishes. God answered these prayers of yours in three miraculous ways:

 Prior to our departure for Cuba, officials informed us that our religious teachers visa applications were denied but that we could still enter the country for "cultural exchange." This meant that we could minister to pastors in their homes but not hold large group meetings. However, upon scanning my passport in Houston, we discovered that I had, indeed, been granted a religious teachers visa so the pastors conference could move forward as previously planned!

- We brought with us four suitcases filled with Bibles and Bible study resources to give to national pastors and their wives. Not only were all four suitcases admitted into the country, customs didn't require us to open or unload a single one!
- At passport control in Cuba, officials possess the power to deny you entry into the country as well as limit your travel or activities. Despite extensive questioning, by your prayers no such restrictions were placed upon us!



Build up one another

Additionally, we requested that you pray 1 Thessalonians 5:11 for our ministry in Cuba, keeping in mind our call to *encourage one another and build up one another, just as [we] also are doing* for pastors around the globe. God answered this second set of your prayers in three providential ways:

- Despite a lack of fuel in the province, 50 Baptist pastors traveled miles by foot, horse, and cart to attend the Pastors Equipping Conference. This number is significant because it is the maximum number of people allowed by law to publicly gather so God packed the church!
- In addition to this ministry to church leaders, we led two lay persons in making a confession of faith and prayed over a couple who desired to re-dedicate their marriage to Christ!
- Finally, the couple who ran the guest house in which we stayed was so touched by our behavior and prayers for their health that they asked to join the church that hosted the conference!
