



## Nigeria Bound

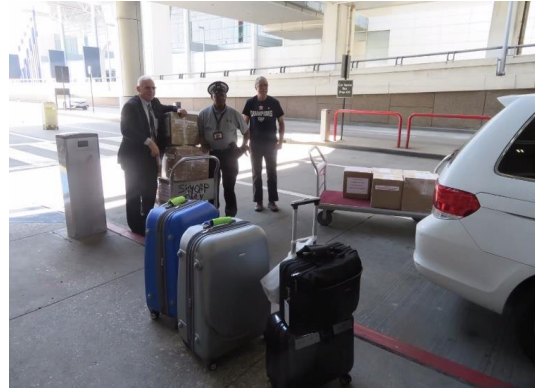

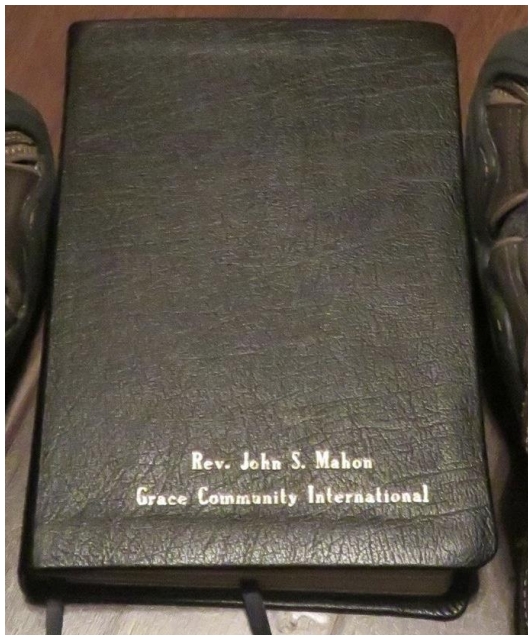
## Safety from satanic attack
