- IV. Prayer Requests: As you pray, please allow the accompanying passage from the Word of God to guide your prayers:

2 Corinthians 1:11 “you also joining in helping us through your prayers, so that thanks may be given by many persons on our behalf for the favor bestowed on us through the prayers of many.”

A. Ask God to bless the ministry of the Word in Nigeria - please claim *Isaiah 55:11:*

- So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth; It will not return to Me empty,*
- Without accomplishing what I desire,*
- And without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.*

B. Please intercede on our behalf as we seek to pass through customs with over 20 - 50lb. boxes of Bibles, Bible study aids and Bible reference works for pastors, seminary students, student workers and lay ministers. (For many, this will be the first leather study Bible they have ever owned and will exceed their monthly salary in cost.)

- Proverbs 21:1 The king's heart is like channels of water in the hand of the LORD; He turns it wherever He wishes.*
- Daniel 1:9 Now God granted Daniel favor and compassion in the sight of the commander of the officials,*
- Acts 7:9-10 The patriarchs became jealous of Joseph and sold him into Egypt. Yet God was with him, and rescued him from all his afflictions, and granted him favor and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh, king of Egypt, and he made him governor over Egypt and all his household.*

C. Please claim these promises of protection for Emeka, myself and the team going to Nigeria:

2 Thessalonians 3:1-4

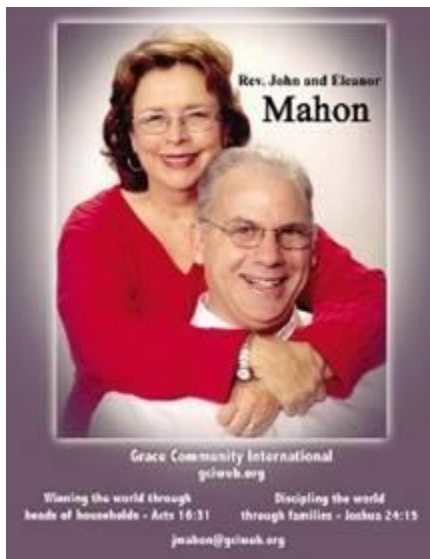
- Finally, brethren, pray for us that the word of the Lord will spread rapidly and be glorified, just as it did also with you;*
- 2 and that we will be rescued from perverse and evil men; for not all have faith.*
- 3 But the Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.*

- You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.*

D. Ask that God would bless the ministry materially, that we might, in turn, bless those to whom we minister. We ask only for the privilege of blessing the churches to which we minister in Russia, Africa and throughout the world:

- Luke 6:38 "Give, and it will be given to you.*
- They will pour into your lap a good measure –*
- pressed down, shaken together, and running over.*
- For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return."*

I close this email, as always, with a deep and abiding thankfulness for your sacrificial and effectual prayers, which empower and drive this ministry ever forward in the cause of Christ.

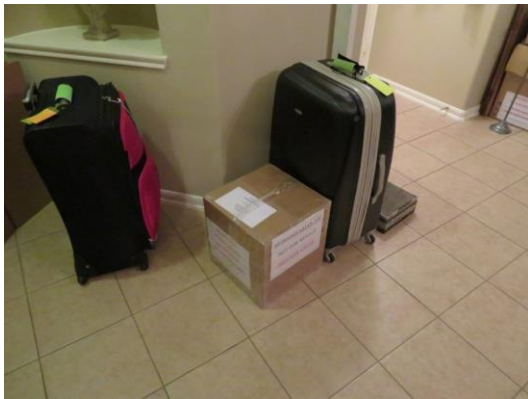
