
## Prayer Dispatch 06.29.14 / Prayer Requests As Departure For Nigeria Nears

As the time nears for my departure for Nigeria I would ask that you continue to lift up the prayer requests from last week's dispatch. This is just brief dispatch with five important prayer requests.

**1. Visas for Nigeria and Cameroon** – As of Friday the applications were at the Nigerian Embassy still waiting for action on their part.

**2.** Packing Party Thursday July 3<sup>rd</sup> - Our Home (all are invited) Ask God to bless the packing party as we prepare boxes of Bibles, Bible study aids and Bible reference works

for Nigeria. They are piled in our foyer and awaiting to be sorted, boxed, weighed, sealed and labeled.

**3. Wisdom in the use of time** during my brief stay here in Houston between mission trips

We ask nothing for ourselves but only for the privilege of ministering to the material and spiritual needs of national pastors, ministers, staff, student workers and foreign missionaries.
