



Engaging in Home Evangelism in Tyumen

Your faith, prayers, and gifts are making a difference in Tyumen as we host a series of evangelistic home meetings! Central to our call in every country in which GCI ministers are the questions of "*How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed? How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher?*" (Romans 10:14). To this end, every Friday evening we are involved in Evangelistic Home Meetings. On some nights, a member of the church acts as the host and invites family or friends to hear the gospel. On other evenings, we host a gathering in our flat for dinner and an evangelistic talk followed by fun games for the whole family. Regardless of the

setting, Bibles come out and the gospel is clearly presented alongside an opportunity for those attending to pray to receive Christ.



So faith comes from hearing...

In Romans 10:17, God the Holy Spirit teaches us that “faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.” And Scripture speaks of how “the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God” (2 Corinthians 4:4).

Yet we know that the solution consists of two parts. We take up the first part as found in 2 Corinthians 4:5 which exhorts us to “not preach ourselves but Christ Jesus as Lord, and ourselves as your bond-servants for Jesus' sake.” The second half of the solution rests with you as “I urge you, brethren, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to strive together with me in your prayers to God for me” (Romans 15:30). As we faithfully preach Christ as Savior in Tyumen, we look to you to send forth a tidal wave of prayer so that the Gospel might penetrate the darkness and those hearing might come to faith in Christ.

Through your faith and prayers, the Russian government provided us with a Religious Teachers Visa which allows us to teach the Scriptures. We praise God for your faith and sacrificial prayers which made this possible! Now we ask you to go one step further. Earnestly and fervently pray that God will empower the sharing of the Gospel through His holy written Word that men and women might repent of their sins and come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.
