<p>2 Corinthians 4:5</p>  <p>For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake.</p> <p>Worldliness - C1</p> <p>ESV</p>	<p>2 Corinthians 6:3-4</p>  <p>We put no obstacle in anyone's way, so that no fault may be found with our ministry, but as servants of God we commend ourselves in every way: by great endurance, in afflictions, hardships, calamities,</p> <p>Worldliness - C2</p> <p>ESV</p>
<p>2 Corinthians 6:5-6</p>  <p>beatings, imprisonments, riots, labors, sleepless nights, hunger; by purity, knowledge, patience, kindness, the Holy Spirit, genuine love;</p> <p>Worldliness - C3</p> <p>ESV</p>	<p>2 Corinthians 6:7-8</p>  <p>by truthful speech, and the power of God; with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and for the left; through honor and dishonor, through slander and praise.
