<p>Matthew 25:22 </p> <p>And he also who had the two talents came forward, saying, 'Master, you delivered to me two talents; here, I have made two talents more.'</p> <p>Stewardship - B5 ESV</p>	<p>Matthew 25:23 </p> <p>His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. <p>Luke 6:34 </p> <p>And if you lend to those from whom you expect to receive, what credit is that to you? Even sinners lend to sinners, to get back the same amount.</p> <p>Stewardship - B7 ESV</p>	<p>Luke 6:35-36 </p> <p>But love your enemies, and do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return, and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, for he is kind to the ungrateful and the evil. Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful.</p> <p>Stewardship - B8 ESV</p>
<p>Luke 12:48 </p> <p>But the one who did not know, and did what deserved a beating, will receive a light beating. Everyone to whom much was given, of him much will be required, and from him to whom they entrusted much, they will demand the more.</p> <p>Stewardship - B9 ESV</p>	<p>Luke 16:8 </p> <p>The master commended the dishonest manager for his shrewdness. For the sons of this world are more shrewd in dealing with their own generation than the sons of light.</p> <p>Stewardship - B10 ESV</p>

<p>Luke 16:9 </p> <p>And I tell you, make friends for yourselves by means of unrighteous wealth, so that when it fails they may receive you into the eternal dwellings.</p> <p>Stewardship - C1 ESV</p>	<p>Luke 16:10 </p> <p>“One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much, and one who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much.</p> <p>Stewardship - C2 ESV</p>
<p>Luke 16:11 </p> <p>If then you have not been faithful in the unrighteous wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches?</p> <p>Stewardship - C3 ESV</p>	<p>Luke 16:12 </p> <p>And if you have not been faithful in that which is another's, who will give you that which is your own?</p> <p>Stewardship - C4 ESV</p>
<p>Luke 16:13 </p> <p>No servant can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money.”</p> <p>Stewardship - C5 ESV</p>	<p>1 Corinthians 4:2 </p> <p>Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful.</p> <p>Stewardship - C6 ESV</p>
<p>Colossians 3:23-24 </p> <p>Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ.</p> <p>Stewardship - C7 ESV</p>	<p>2 Thessalonians 3:10-11 </p> <p>For even when we were with you, we would give you this command: If anyone is not willing to work, let him not eat. For we hear that some among you walk in idleness, not busy at work, but busybodies.</p> <p>Stewardship - C8 ESV</p>
<p>1 Timothy 5:8 </p> <p>But if anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for members of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.</p> <p>Stewardship - C9 ESV</p>	<p>1 Peter 4:10 </p> <p>As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace:</p> <p>Stewardship - C10 ESV</p>
