4 Say to those with anxious heart, "Take courage, fear not. Behold, your God will come with vengeance; The recompense of God will come, But He will save you."


Hebrews 3:13 "But encourage one another day after day, as long as it is still called "Today," so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin."

I invited the pastor's and elders to come forward and pray for the ministry of the Word of God in the lives of the congregation.




Sunday Service (Johannesburg, South Africa)




Training pastors and ministers - Kabwe, Zambia
