- ☐ Isaiah 30:21 Your ears will hear a word behind you, "This is the way, walk in it," whenever you turn to the right or to the left.


B. Built Up In The Word

Didn't we just do this? El packs and unpacks our life for the 5th time in two weeks, traveling an average of five to six hours inland each time to support me in the ministry. How I praise God for a godly and loving wife who will stand by me as my helpmate in very trying and difficult ministry tasks. Few have such a blessing and I do not take her sacrificial love lightly nor for granted. Pray for Eleanor that God will sustain and bless her for her faith, vision and zeal for the Lord.
